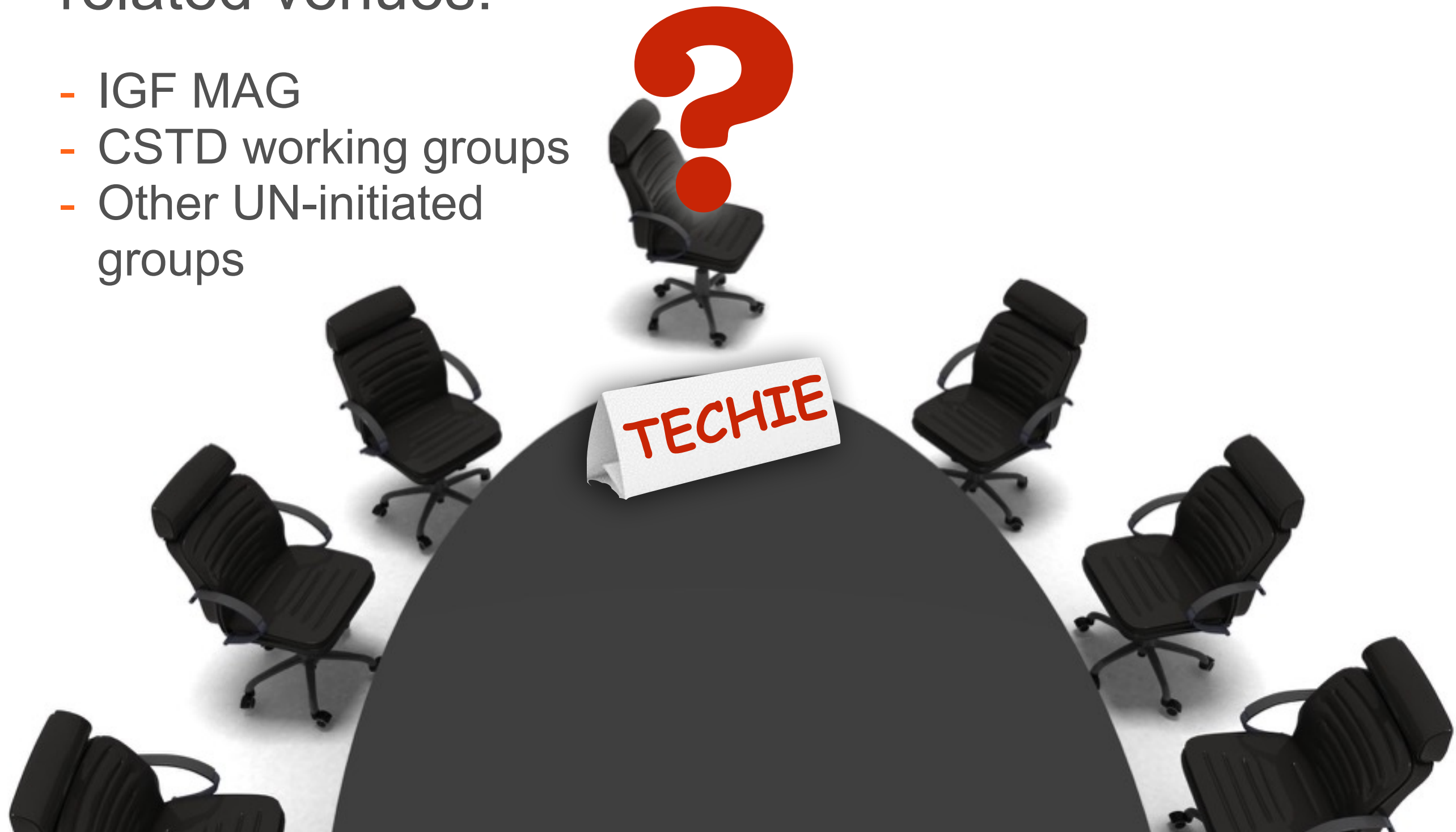

Role of the Technical Community



- Provide perspective from those who designed, built, develop and operate the Internet
 - Inform public policy discussion with specific technical information
 - Explain the technical reasoning behind decisions made in the design and architecture of the Internet
 - Provide historical perspective on the governance principles and processes developed and employed by the technical community
 - Influence decision-making to respect the underlying technical principles of the Internet itself

Challenges



- There is a need for greater transparency
