

Situation in the Netherlands

- Refugees centrally registered by Centraal Orgaan opvang Asielzoekers (COA)
- It's COA policy to provide Internet access at its centers
- COA is overwhelmed with large influx
- COA doesn't provide services to undocumented migrants

Activities


- Provide wired Internet access in (semi-)permanent locations

Requirements

- Portable and sturdy (eviction or demonstration)
- Minimal state (privacy)
- Shareable bandwith
- Reasonable security expectations
- Landingpage // information page
- Remote administation
- Reasonably priced

Prelimenary findings

- No existing cheap hardware that can do rate limiting + landingpage
- Netaidkit has nice security features but too low specs
- OpenWRT seems like a bit of a pain
- Raspberry Pi is very versatile and runs Debian

You're on an internet connnection which is provided for migrants and refugees to enable their right to freedom of expression and access for information. This hotspot aims remove obstacles that refugees and migrants experience to access the Internet.

Usage and security - a word of caution

You're on a political network that is powered by a 3G mobile data connection. This means that the amount of data which can be transferred per month in limited. That's why the connection speed is limited to 50kb/s.

This is an open WiFi network. This means people in the vicinity could scan the network for traffic. To protect yourself, verify websites use HTTPS/SSL when you send sensitive information. Also consider using Tor to anonymize your browsing behavior. You can install Tor for PC, Mac, and Android.


