NWI-1

- ❑ Idea raised by Denis Walker on the mailing list
- ❑ The resource holder could be unaware of changes made to the abuse contact details for his/her resources
- ❑ Result of any addition, change or deletion of any part of the abuse contact details put in his/her ORGANISATION object

- ❑ Currently in the phase 1 of NWI proces – looking for a consensus on the problem statement
- ❑ Please comment on the mailing list!

NWI-1 – possible solution (1)

- ❑ Idea by Danis Walker sent to the mailing list – could be used later on during the phase 2 of the NWI process
- ❑ Another attribute of the ORGANISATION object:
`abuse-notif: [required] [multiple] []`
- ❑ Allow to keep an audit trail of any changes made to the abuse contact details for any parts of the resources



NWI-1 – possible solution (2)

- ❑ „required” - business rules enforce it's presence in some situations
- ❑ Should be added to any ORGANISATION object referenced by a resource object
- ❑ Only the "abuse-notif:" referenced via the top level of a resource object will be notified
